ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: A Minimum of 5 (five) 'O' Level Passes Including English Language at Grade C or Better, 'O' Level Mathematics may be required for some undergraduate programmes.

4 Years: Applicants must have a minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language and Mathematics at Grade C or better.

3 Years: Applicants must have a minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language and Mathematics at Grade C or better and a relevant National Diploma from a recognised institution

2 Years: Applicants must have a minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language and Mathematics at Grade C or better and a relevant Higher National Diploma from a recognised institution.

Masters Degree

Applicants must have a minimum of a relevant first degree at 2.1 or better from a recognised institution.

Doctor of Philosophy (3 - 8 years)

A relevant master's degree with a merit or better from a recognised institution.
